A. Quickly Identify Location of Reference Works.

Instantly distinguish E-reference from print titles held by your library. Clicking on 'Online' or 'At Our Library' restricts results to a desired format.

B. Open E-reference titles directly or through OpenURL.

Additionally, clicking on the *title* of each work opens your library's local record, which contains its own link to the electronic repository.

C. Use expanded Search and Browse Options.

Search and Browse functions support Keyword; Article Title; Index Term; Boolean queries and more.

D. Refine Search via Subject Headings.

Faceted search capability allows for greater context analysis of search results.

E. Utilize Additional Search Options.

Expanded search options permit Boolean operators; word variants; exact phrase and additional options.

F. Free your Reference Collection from your Catalog!

Reference Universe matches your collection at the *index* level, thereby unlock local content in a way your library catalog cannot.





G. Limit your query to Titles Not Held.

An invaluable utility for *collection development* applications, *weeding* or *relocation*, this one-click option permits library staff to identify additional titles for assessment.

H. Export Records in a Variety of Formats.

Reference Universe supports exporting a large number of reference citations. Titles can be exported in *Brief*, *Full*, *RefWorks* or *EndNotes* format.

Quick Tips:

-  Use simple words/phrases: for best results, e.g., *sustainability*; *dark matter*; *Descartes*.
-  Use Wild Card operators to expand coverage e.g., *visionar**
-  Select "View Index Entries" to see detailed contents of each work and narrow search topic.
-  Click on title each work to find location of the print title in your library, or link to the ebook if not present in the citation itself.
